Priority of Access Policy

Lockleys North Primary School is a zoned school (see attached map) across all year levels and enrolments from outside of the zone are in high demand. This means that we may not have vacancies for all students who would like to enrol. The capacity of the school and the needs of the students determine the maximum number of students who can enrol.

The school can provide a high quality, safe program for all students by ensuring that enrolments are maintained at a reasonable level. The Principal, Early Years Team and Governing Council work together using the Department for Education and Child Development guidelines to define the maximum number of enrolments each year. When the number of enrolments approaches this capacity the 'Priority of Access' Policy is utilised.

The priorities of access are:

First Priority

Students who have a residential address in the zoned area.

Please be aware you may be asked for documents showing proof of residence including:

- *gas or electricity bill*
- *copy of the property's contract of sale*
- *rental agreement or bond receipt*
- *parenting order from the Family Court with the address of a full-time carer.*

Second Priority

Students who already have siblings enrolled at the school.

Where a student's brother or sister currently attends the school, they also have the right to attend the school. If no one in the family has attended the school for a year or more then the 'sibling rights priority' no longer applies. Students must live at the same primary permanent address and provide proof of residence to be eligible for the 'sibling rights priority' if they are:

- *step brothers or sisters who are not blood relatives*
- *from a blended family living in a de facto relationship*

Third Priority

Students closest in proximity to the school on the Out of Zone Waiting List.

If the school has reached its capacity only students who live inside the zone will be able to enrol. Families with students who are outside the zone have the choice of putting their children on our waiting list for consideration if a vacancy becomes available. *(Please note: If you are placed on a waiting list the priority of access listed above will still be followed when determining enrolments).*
